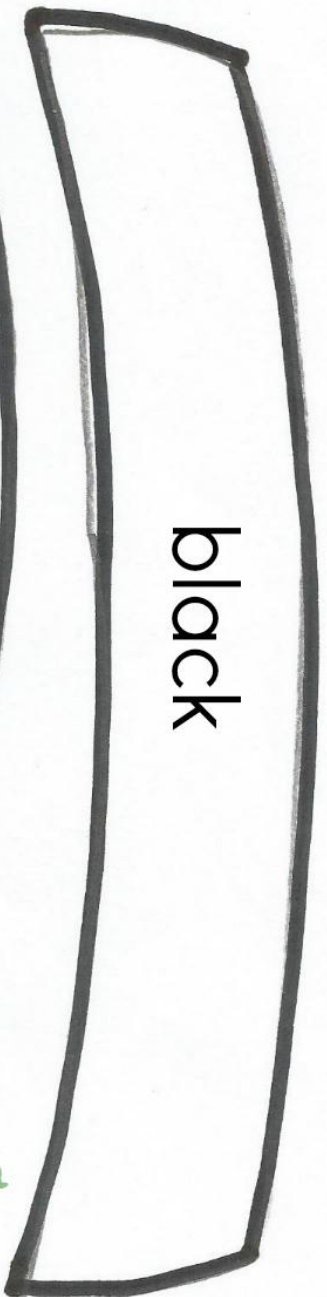
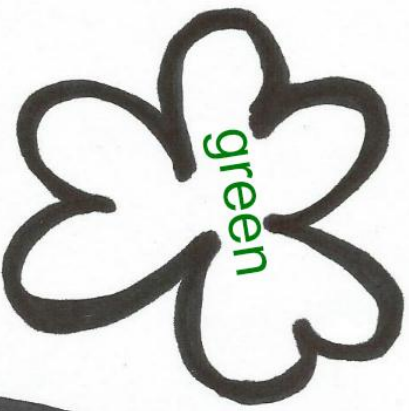
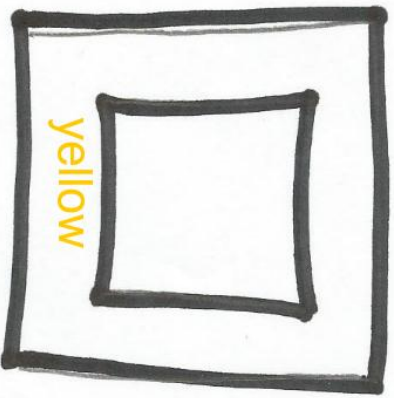
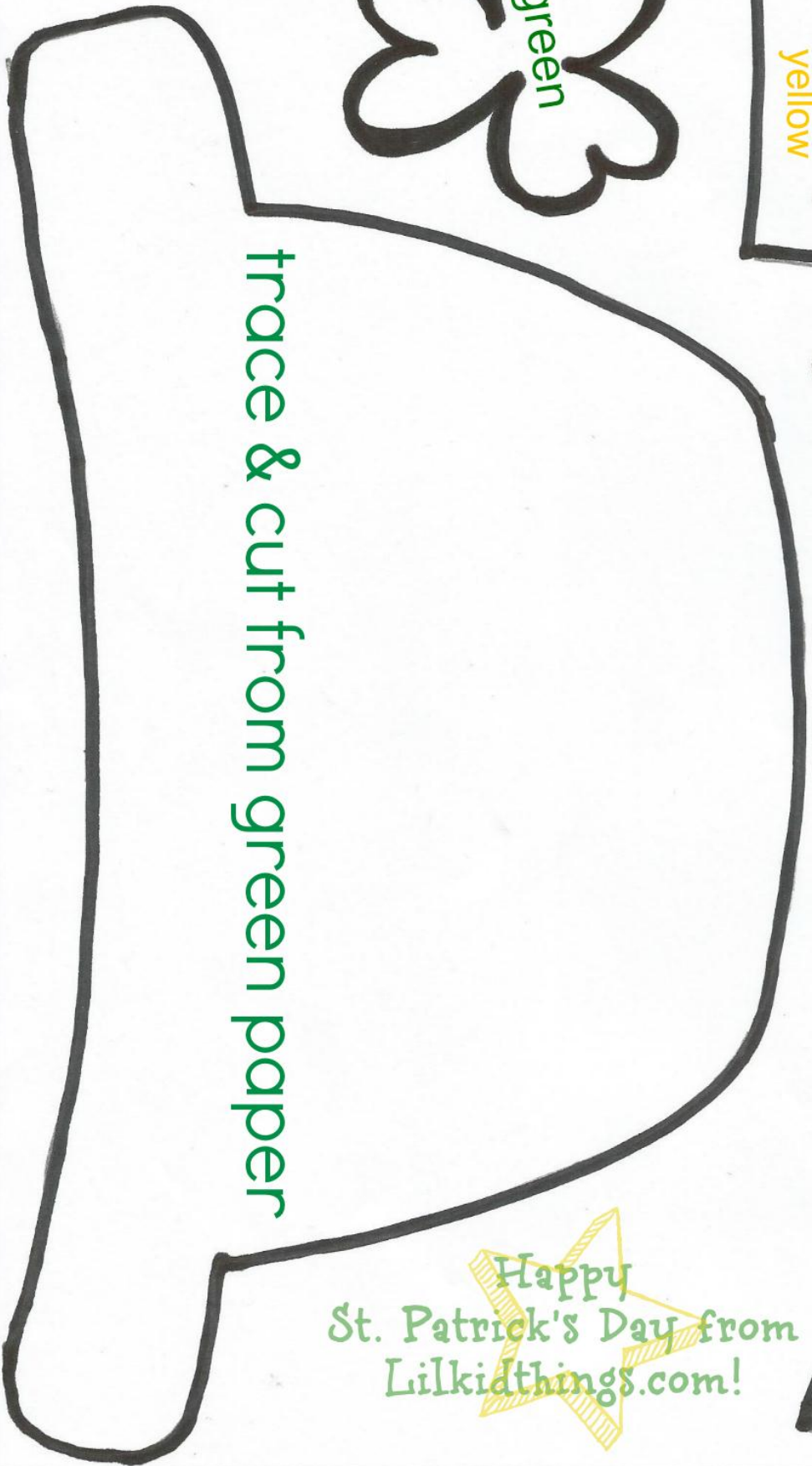


DIY Leprechaun Hats for Kids!

Materials needed:

- 1 sheet of cardstock
- 2 Sheets of green construction paper
- 1 sheet of black construction paper
- 1 sheet of yellow construction paper
- 1 green pipe cleaner (cut in half)
- Tape
- Glue
- Gold glitter (green glitter if desired also)

Assembly instructions:

- Print template onto cardstock and cut out shapes
- Trace hat and shamrock onto one sheet of green paper and cut out
- Trace hat ribbon onto black paper and cut out
- Trace buckle onto yellow paper and cut out
- Allow child to decorate the hat and shamrock with green markers, crayons or glitter and glue
- Use gold glitter and glue for the belt buckle

To assemble your child's hat:

1. Cut the extra sheet of green paper into equal strips (using the longer side of the paper).
2. Measure your child's head and cut strips to make a headband for the hat and tape strips together.
3. Attach the strips of paper to the back of the hat using tape and flip the hat over
4. Tape the pipe cleaner to the front of the hat under the area where the black ribbon will go
5. Tape the shamrock to the other end of the pipe cleaner
6. Glue the black ribbon to the hat and the yellow belt buckle on top of the ribbon.

Let dry and you have yourself a leprechaun! Enjoy!
